Pre-Teen Social Club is a 10-week evidence-based social skills program for elementary school-aged children who have difficulty making and keeping friends.

During each group session, children are taught crucial social skills and are given the opportunity to practice these skills in session during role-play and play activities.

During the social skills group,

- Find common interests with peers
- Use appropriate conversation skills
- Make a good first impression
- Join a group of kids at play
- Be a good sport
- Be a good host on a play date
- Handle rejection, teasing, and bullying
- Handle disagreements with friends

Instructor: Registered Clinical Psychologist

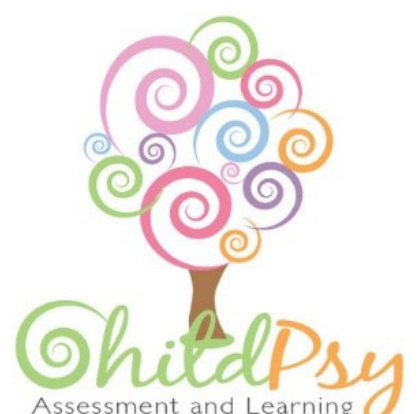
Fee: \$7000 (10 sessions)
