Foundation English Reading and Writing programme for students in Early years, **Key Stage 1 & 2:**

- Secure letter knowledge
- Improve reading, spelling and handwriting skills.
- Foster automaticity by emphasising on memory work and speed of retrieval.
- Ensure a good foundation for understanding literacy concepts e.g. suffixing, spelling rules, syllable division etc.
- Develop strategies to increase the capacity for storing information in working memory in order to support classroom activities
- Develop comprehension, higher order literacy skills and study skills e.g. scanning, note-making etc.

Advance English Reading and Writing programme for students in **Key Stage 2 & 3:**

- Develop use of vocabulary, grammar, understanding of different writing genres.
- Conduct research and to express ideas clearly in different academic formats including narrative and argumentative writings.

Duration: 60 minutes (individual session), 75 minutes (pair/group session)
